Format: 36 holes stroke play; 18 holes per day.

Start Times:

Boys Championship & Girls Championship Flights

- Monday, November 21 11:00 a.m. shotgun Laguna Seca
- Tuesday, November 22 8:00 a.m. tee times; off tees 1 and 10 Del Monte

Boys First & Girls First Flights

- Monday, November 21 11:00 a.m. shotgun Del Monte
- Tuesday, November 22 8:00 a.m. tee times; off tees 1 and 10 Laguna Seca

Registration: There will be registration opening at 9:00 a.m. on Monday. There will be no registration on Tuesday, players should arrive at their designated tee at least 10 minutes prior to their start time.

Announcements: On Monday only, announcements will occur at the check in table next to the putting green at 10:30 a.m. At 10:40 a.m. players will start to their holes.

Shuttling:

Monday: Shuttling will start at 10:40 p.m. Players will be shuttle to the furthest holes at each course, the holes will be announced on Monday.

*Tuesday at Del Monte: For players teeing off of tee 10, a shuttle will be available.

Players must meet at the shuttle at least 20 minutes before their tee time. The shuttle will be located on the putting green next to the back door of the golf shop. It is the players' responsibility to be at the tee on time and ready to play. The NCGA will be shuttling on a strict schedule and will not be responsible for players who arrive late to the shuttle pick up. There will be no shuttle at Laguna Seca.

Time of Starting: Players are responsible for showing up and ready to play on time to their correct tee. The player will be penalized for arriving after their time and disqualified for showing up after 4 minutes 59 seconds after their starting time. The official starting time will be posted at jtnc.org. The course will not page players to the tee.

Range: Golf balls will be available at Laguna Seca only, Del Monte does not have a driving range. The driving range at Laguna Seca will open at 9:00 a.m. on Monday and 7:00 a.m. on Tuesday. Other ranges in the area include Bayonet/Blackhorse GC, Laguna Seca GC, and Poppy Hills GC.

Practice Rounds: Practice rounds are available, please contact the golf shop for tee time and rate information. Both courses are Youth On Course participating facilities and will offer special rates for YOC members.

Del Monte: The junior rate is\$60, YOC rates are available in the afternoon, a special \$30 rate is available starting at 11a.m. on Sunday November 20.

Laguna Seca: The junior rate is \$45 before noon, \$10 after noon, players that are members of Youth on Course may use the \$5 YOC rate.

Food Service: Food will be available both days for players. Monday, a box lunch will be available at registration. Tuesday, a BBQ style lunch will be available at the completion of the round. Players requiring special dietary needs, please contact Aaron or Kelly ahead of time. If you do not contact the JTNC ahead of time you can also request a special lunch at registration.

Restaurant: The restaurants will be open for breakfast and lunch. Restaurant hours are 6:30 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. snacks will be available after 4.

Second Round Pairings: Second round pairings will be available after all first round scores are posted. The pairing will be available at itnc.org on the contestant information page.

Rules of Play: The 6 USGA Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the JTNC rules card. The committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed on the tournament days. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the conditions of the competition.

Walking: Players must walk at all times, except as authorized by the Committee. Caddies are not permitted. Pull or push carts are permitted.

Distance – Measuring Devices: A player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. However, if, during a stipulated round, a player uses a device that is designed to measure other conditions that might affect his play, the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional function is actually used.

<u>Dress Code</u>: Players and Spectators must be properly attired both on the golf course and on the premises of the club. Blue jeans, designer jeans, T-shirts and tank tops are prohibited. Golf shirts must be worn and shorts must be of appropriate length (no jean shorts). This dress code will be used at all JTNC competitions in conjunction with any additional dress code restrictions of the particular golf course involved. A violation of this dress code must be rectified without undue delay or the player will not be allowed to continue play. Spectators violating will be asked to change or leave the club.

<u>Caddies Prohibited:</u> Caddies are not allowed at this event. If a person other than the player moves the cart in a "casual act" the *Rules of Golf* do not consider this individual to be a caddie. There is no breach of Rule 6-4.

Spectators: Spectators must wear proper attire while at the club. Please see the Dress Code policy above.

The use of electronic devices should be limited to areas where their use will not distract players on the course. Spectators must maintain at least 25 yards from the players and avoid even the appearance of imparting advice or assisting the player in any way. A spectator may approach a player briefly to hand clothing, food or beverages to the player, but should not have prolonged conversations. Please walk ahead of the group you are following and stay in the rough or near the cart paths. Do not delay groups by walking slowly. Spectators must stay off the greens and out of the bunkers at all times. Spectators violating these policies may be asked to leave the course. Spectator carts are prohibited. Handicap carts will be available for \$17 per person. Individuals must have documentation and be cleared by the JTNC staff. Please visit the registration table on Saturday to be cleared or find a JTNC staff on Sunday.

Ties: In the event of ties, there will be a play-off for first place. Ties for second and third will be decided using the USGA's method for matching cards. In a competition with a multiple tee start, the last nine holes will be holes 10-18.

Footwear: Non-metal spikes required. Shoes with traditionally designed spikes (regardless of composition, i.e., ceramic) or spikes, regardless of design, comprised either entirely or partially of metal (when such metal comes in contact with the surface of the putting green) are prohibited. Penalty for breach of this condition: Disqualification.

Withdrawals & No Shows: Players who enter a JTNC event and wish to withdraw for any reason MUST notify the JTNC/NCGA staff at the Rules and Competitions department at (831) 625-4653. Failure to notify the JTNC/NCGA will result in a NO SHOW and the player will receive a one-year suspension from all JTNC events for the following calendar year following the infraction. A player who only contacts the course and NOT the JTNC/NCGA will incur the suspension.
