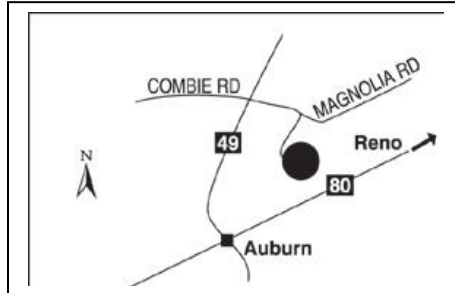

FORMAT: 36 holes stroke play

START TIMES FOR ALL FLIGHTS:

Saturday - 12:30 Shotgun *ALL players **must check in** at least 30 minutes before their tee time at the registration table to receive their materials. Registration will begin 2 hours before the shotgun start.

Sunday - Tee times beginning at 8:00 am off of #1 and #10 *Players are not required to check in before their round. Players are asked to arrive at their assigned tee ten minutes before their assigned tee time.

RULES OF PLAY: The **2012-2015** USGA Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the NCGA rules card. The committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed on the tournament days. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the conditions of the competition.

TEES: Boys Championship – **Copper**; Boys First / Girls Championship – **White**; Girls First – **Jade**.

WALKING: Players must walk at all times, except as authorized by the Committee. Caddies are not permitted. Pull or push carts are permitted. **Spectator carts are prohibited.**

PRACTICE ROUNDS: Practice rounds are available by contacting the Darkhorse Golf Shop (530) 269-7900 to arrange a tee time. Practice rounds are available for players at the junior rate of \$20 on weekdays and after 11:00am on weekends. Please identify yourself as a contestant in the competition. Parents wishing to play will pay the going rate at the time of play.

DRESS CODE: Refer to NCGA rules card. **SPECTATORS MUST BE DRESSED ACCORDING TO NCGA GUIDELINES. NO DENIM ALLOWED FOR PLAYERS OR SPECTATORS. SHORTS MUST BE NO SHORTER THAN 3" ABOVE THE KNEE. DRESS CODE WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.**

FOOTWEAR: Shoes with traditionally designed spikes (regardless of composition, i.e., ceramic) or spikes, regardless of design, comprised either entirely or partially of metal (when such metal comes in contact with the surface of the putting green) are prohibited. **NO METAL SPIKES ALLOWED.** Penalty for breach of this condition: **DISQUALIFICATION.**

GOLF SHOP & PRACTICE RANGE: The Golf Shop and Practice Range will be open to players at 11:00AM on Saturday and 7:00AM on Sunday. Players are asked to limit their range use to one bucket of balls. Players are asked to be considerate of other players and use their time on the range as a warm up, not a practice session. Players who are abusing their driving range privileges will be asked to step aside to make room for other players. The range will be open to players after their round. Range balls must be purchased by the player during this time.

SPECTATORS: Spectators are welcomed throughout the competition. They must remain at least 25 yards from any competitor and may not provide advice during the play of either round. Violation of this prohibition could result in the disqualification of the player. Spectator carts will not be permitted.

FOOD SERVICE: A box lunch will be provided to the players at 11:00 am Saturday at the registration table. A barbeque lunch will be provide for the players after their round on Sunday.

WITHDRAWALS & NO SHOWS: Refer to the NCGA rules card. Players who enter a NCGA event and wish to withdraw for any reason must notify the NCGA Rules and Competitions Department at (831) 625-4653. Failure to notify the NCGA will result in a NO SHOW and the player will receive a ONE-YEAR SUSPENSION FROM ALL NCGA EVENTS FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR FOLLOWING THE INFRACTION. A player who only contacts the course and NOT the NCGA will incur the suspension.

LATE APPEARANCE: Starters will not page players in advance of their starting time. Players are solely responsible for knowing their starting times and all players in a group must be present and ready to play at the time laid down by the Committee. The order of play is not relevant. "Ready to play" means on their assigned tee, with a ball and golf club in hand.

PLAYOFF: There will be a play-off for first place in each flight if necessary. Ties for second and third will be broken by a scorecard playoff.

POSTING SCORES: NCGA staff will post tournament scores at the conclusion of the tournament. Players are asked to refrain from posting tournament scores to avoid duplication.
