**FORMAT:** 36 holes stroke play; 18 holes per day

***All participants will play the Coyote Creek Valley course both days.***

**START TIMES:**

**All Flights:**

**Saturday and Sunday- First tee time at 11:30am; off tee #1**

\*Players are not required to check in before their round. Players are asked to arrive at the tee ten minutes before their assigned tee time.

**RULES OF PLAY:** The **2012-2015** USGA Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the NCGA rules card. The committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed on the tournament days. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the conditions of the competition.

**TEES:** Boys Championship Flight will play from the **white** tee markers; Girls Championship Flight and Boys First Flight will play from the **gold** tee markers; Girls First Flight will play from the **red** tee markers.

\*The Coyote Creek staff has developed a yardage book that is available to players in the pro shop for \$5.

**WALKING:** Players must walk at all times, except as authorized by the Committee. Caddies are not permitted. Pull or push carts are permitted. **Spectator carts are prohibited.**

**PRACTICE ROUND:** Practice rounds will be available Monday through Friday after 1:00. Green fees are \$22 per player. Parents wishing to play will pay the going rate available during their desired time. Cart fees are \$11 per person. The person driving the cart must have a valid driver's license.

**WITHDRAWALS AND NO SHOWS:** Refer to NCGA rules card. Players who enter an NCGA event and wish to withdraw for any reason **MUST** notify the NCGA Championships and Events Department at (831) 625-4653. Failure to notify the NCGA will result in a **NO SHOW** and the player will receive a **ONE-YEAR SUSPENSION FROM**

ALL NCGA EVENTS FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR FOLLOWING THE INFRACTION. A player who only contacts the course and NOT the NCGA will incur the suspension.

**LATE APPEARANCE:** It is the responsibility of the players to be at their assigned tee at the time that the Committee orders play to begin. Order of play is not considered. The course will not page players to the tee.

**FOOTWEAR:** Non-metal spikes required. Shoes with traditionally designed spikes (regardless of composition, i.e., ceramic) or spikes, regardless of design, comprised either entirely or partially of metal (when such metal comes in contact with the surface of the putting green) are prohibited. Penalty for breach of this condition: **DISQUALIFICATION.**

**DRESS CODE:** Refer to NCGA rules card. **SPECTATORS MUST BE DRESSED ACCORDING TO NCGA GUIDELINES. NO DENIM ALLOWED FOR PLAYERS OR SPECTATORS. SHORTS MUST BE NO SHORTER THAN 3" ABOVE THE KNEE. DRESS CODE WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.**

**PLAY-OFF:** A play-off will be held for first place in each flight if necessary. Ties for second and third place will be broken by scorecard playoff. No duplicate medals will be awarded to third place finishers.

**PRO SHOP & RANGE:** The driving range will be available to players. Players will be provided with one bucket of range balls upon arrival to the driving range. Players are asked to be considerate of other players and use their time on the range as a warm up, not a practice session. Players who are abusing their driving range privileges will be asked to step aside to make room for other players.

**FOOD SERVICE:** Box lunches will be provided on Saturday and Sunday at 11:00. The snack bar located between the 9<sup>th</sup> green and 10<sup>th</sup> tee will be open and available to players during their round.
