



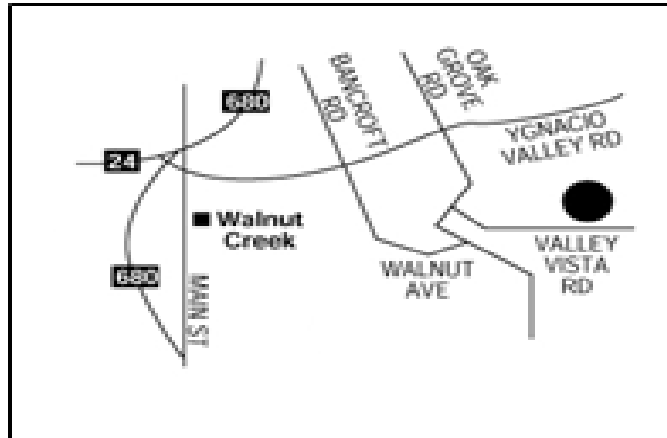

FORMAT: 36 holes stroke play; 18 holes per day.

START TIMES:

All Flights:

Saturday/Sunday- 11:00am Tee start on Hole #1: Start times for each Flight will be the same on Sunday's final round. Boys Champ. 11:00am-11:50am; Girls Champ. 12:00pm-12:40pm; Boys First 12:50pm-1:30pm; Girls First 1:40pm-2:20pm.

REGISTRATION: Registration will be required Saturday and Sunday and will begin at 9:45am.

TEE MARKERS: Boys Championship Flight – Blue; Boys First Flight and Girls Championship Flight – White; Girls First Flight – Red

RULES OF PLAY: The **2012-2015** USGA Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the NCGA rules card. The committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the tee. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the conditions of the competition.

WALKING: Players must walk at all times, except as authorized by the Committee. **Caddies are not permitted.** Pull or push carts are permitted. **Spectator carts are prohibited.**

PRACTICE ROUND: Practice rounds are available for players Monday-Thursday anytime and Friday-Sunday after 3pm for \$15. Others will be at the going rate, call the pro shop for prices and to arrange a time.

WITHDRAWALS AND NO SHOWS: Refer to NCGA rules card. Players who enter an NCGA event and wish to withdraw for any reason MUST notify the NCGA Rules and Competitions Department at (831) 625-4653. Failure to notify the NCGA will result in a NO SHOW and the player will receive a ONE-YEAR SUSPENSION FROM ALL NCGA EVENTS FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR FOLLOWING THE INFRACTION. A player who only contacts the course and NOT the NCGA will incur the suspension.

LATE APPEARANCE: Starters will not page players in advance of their starting time. Players are solely responsible for knowing their starting times and all players in a group must be present and ready to play at the time laid down by the Committee. The order of play is not relevant. "Ready to Play" means on their assigned tee, with a ball and golf club in hand. See "Time of Starting" in the NCGA rules card.

FOOTWEAR: Non-metal spikes required. Shoes with traditionally designed spikes (regardless of composition, i.e., ceramic) or spikes, regardless of design, comprised either entirely or partially of metal (when such metal comes in contact with the surface of the putting green) are prohibited. Penalty for breach of this condition: **DISQUALIFICATION.**

DRESS CODE: Refer to NCGA rules card. **SPECTATORS MUST BE DRESSED ACCORDING TO NCGA GUIDELINES. NO DENIM ALLOWED FOR PLAYERS OR SPECTATORS. SHORTS MUST BE NO SHORTER THAN 3" ABOVE THE KNEE. DRESS CODE WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.**

PLAY-OFF: There will be a play-off for first in each flight if necessary. Ties for second place and third place will be broken by a scorecard playoff. The scorecard playoff will start with the final 9 holes, final 6, final 3 and hole 18. Refer to Appendix 1, item 10 in The Rules of Golf Decisions Book.

RANGE: Will be available Saturday and Sunday morning for players, and will open at 7:00 am. **Players must pick up a range coin at the registration table.** Players are asked to be considerate of other players and use their time on the range as a warm up, not a practice session. Players who are abusing their driving range privileges will be asked to step aside to make room for other players.

FOOD SERVICE: Box lunches will be provided at each day. Players must pick up a Lunch ticket at registration to receive a box lunch in the restaurant.
