PLAYER INFORMATION SHEET

Listed below is IMPORTANT tournament information. Please read carefully.

CLUB LOCATION: 15571 Alum Rock Ave; San Jose, CA – Pro Shop: 408-258-4901

FORMAT: 36 holes stroke play; 18 holes per day.

REGISTRATION: Players must check in with the registration table each day of competition before their round begins.

DRIVING RANGE, PRO SHOP, CLUBHOUSE: Will open at 6:15 am on day two.

TEES: Boys Championship Flight – **Blue Tees; Girls Championship Flight and Boys First Flight – **White Tees**; Girls First Flight – **Red Tees**.**

RULES OF PLAY: The **2012-2015 USGA Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the NCGA Hard Card. The committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the tee. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the conditions of the competition.**

1ST TEE TIME: 12:00 pm shotgun start on Day 1. 7:30 am shotgun start on Day 2.

WALKING: Players must walk at all times. Caddies are not permitted. Pull or push carts are permitted. **Spectator carts are prohibited. Handicap carts will be available on a limited basis.**

PRACTICE ROUND: NO PRACTICE ROUNDS will be available to contestants.

WITHDRAWALS AND NO SHOWS: Refer to NCGA rules card. Players who enter an NCGA event and wish to withdraw for any reason MUST notify the NCGA Rules and Competitions Department at (831) 625-4653. Failure to notify the NCGA will result in a NO SHOW and the player will receive a ONE-YEAR SUSPENSION FROM ALL NCGA EVENTS FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR FOLLOWING THE INFRACTION. A player who only contacts the course and NOT the NCGA will incur the suspension.

LATE APPEARANCE: Starters will not page players in advance of their starting time. Players are solely responsible for knowing their starting times and must be present and ready to play at the time laid down by the Committee. The order of play is not relevant. "Ready to Play" means the player must be standing on the tee, and have a golf ball and golf club in hand. See "Time of Starting" in the NCGA rules card. The note to Rule 6-3 will be in effect.

FOOTWEAR: Non-metal spikes required. Shoes with traditionally designed spikes (regardless of composition, i.e., ceramic) or spikes, regardless of design, comprised either entirely or partially of metal (when such metal comes in contact with the surface of the putting green) are prohibited. Penalty for breach of this condition: **DISQUALIFICATION.**

DRESS CODE: Proper golf attire is **absolutely required of players and spectators. Denim, short shorts, tank tops, or clothing with ripped or torn edges is prohibited per club dress code. Shorts must be no shorter than 4" above the knee. Hats and visors must be removed while indoors. Athletic apparel is not permitted. **Any Junior Tour player or spectator in violation of the dress code will be asked to change or leave the premises.****

CELL PHONES: Club policy requests that guests limit their cell phone use to the parking lot area.

PLAY-OFF: There will be a play-off for first place in each flight if necessary. Ties for second and third place will be broken by a scorecard playoff.

FOOD SERVICE: Box lunches will be available at the registration table at 10:00am on Day 1. A complimentary BBQ lunch will be provided for players from 11:30am-1:00pm on Day 2 on the back patio by the 6th tee. The snack shack will be open from 11:30am-4:30pm on both days.
