PLAYER INFORMATION SHEET

Listed below is IMPORTANT tournament information. Please read carefully.

CLUB LOCATION: 7000 Alameda Drive, Rancho Murieta, Ca. 95683

FORMAT: 36 holes stroke play; 18 holes per day. Day One – Tee Times off #1 South Course - the first tee time will be at 9:00 am; Day Two – Tee Times off #1 & #10 – North Course, the first tee time will be at 8:00 am.

Registration: Registration will open at 8:00 am, Saturday, October 26th. There will be no registration Sunday, October 27th. Check in with the assigned tee, 10 minutes before your tee time for special announcements. **Second day pairings** can be found online at **JTNC.ORG**

TEES: Boys Championship Flight will play from the **Black TEES**. Girls Championship Flight and Boys First Flight will play from the **Gold TEES**. Girls First Flight will play from the **Bronze TEES**. Please see yardages listed on the attached pages.

RULES OF PLAY: The **2012-2015** USGA Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the NCGA rules card. The committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the tee. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the conditions of the competition.

Distance – Measuring Devices: A player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. However, if, during a stipulated round, a player uses a device that is designed to measure other conditions that might affect his play, the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional function is actually used.

WALKING: Players must walk at all times, except as authorized by the Committee. Caddies are not permitted. Pull or push carts are permitted. **Spectator carts are prohibited.**

PRACTICE ROUND: Practice rounds will be available October 19 or 20th after 1:00 pm. If you wish to play a practice round you must make reservations by calling the **Rancho Murieta Golf Shop** at 916-354-2400. The rate is \$25.

WITHDRAWALS AND NO SHOWS: Refer to NCGA rules card. Players who enter an NCGA event and wish to withdraw for any reason MUST notify the NCGA Rules and Competitions Department at (831) 625-4653. Failure to notify the NCGA will result in a NO SHOW and the player will receive a ONE-YEAR SUSPENSION FROM ALL NCGA EVENTS FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR FOLLOWING THE INFRACTION. A player who only contacts the course and NOT the NCGA will incur the suspension.

LATE APPEARANCE: Starters will not page players in advance of their starting time. Players are solely responsible for knowing their starting times and all players in a group must be present and ready to play at the time laid down by the Committee. The order of play is not relevant. See "Time of Starting" in the NCGA rules card.

FOOTWEAR: Non-metal spikes required. Shoes with traditionally designed spikes (regardless of composition, i.e., ceramic) or spikes, regardless of design, comprised either entirely or partially of metal (when such metal comes in contact with the surface of the putting green) are prohibited. Penalty for breach of this condition: **DISQUALIFICATION.**

DRESS CODE: Refer to NCGA rules card.

PLAY-OFF: There will be a play-off for first in each flight if necessary. Ties for second place and third place will be broken by a scorecard playoff. The scorecard playoff will start with the final 9 holes, final 6, final 3 and hole 18. Refer to Appendix 1, item 10 in The Rules of Golf Decisions Book.

RANGE: Will be available Saturday and Sunday morning for players, and will open at 7:00 am. Balls will be set up on the range. Players are asked to be considerate of other players and use their time on the range as a warm up, not a practice session. Players who are abusing their driving range privileges will be asked to step aside to make room for other players.

PRO SHOP & RANGE: Open at 7:00 AM.

RESTAURANT: Open at 7:00 AM, lunch will be provided both days to players after their round.
