Format: 36 holes stroke play; 18 holes per day

Start Times:

Saturday- 1:00 pm shotgun start

*Registration begins at 11:00am ALL players must check in at least 30 minutes before the shotgun start at the registration table to receive their materials. Registration will begin 2 hours before the shotgun start.

Sunday-8:00 am 1st tee time; off tees 1 and 10

*There is no registration. Players should arrive 10 minutes before their tee time for special course instructions.

Second Round Pairings: Second round pairings will be available after all first round scores are posted. The pairing will be available at itnc.org on the contestant information page.

Rules of Play: The 2012-2015 USGA Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the JTNC rules card. The committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed on the tournament days. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the conditions of the competition.

<u>Distance - Measuring Devices:</u> A player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. However, if, during a stipulated round, a player uses a device that is designed to measure other conditions that might affect his play, the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional function is actually used.

Walking: Players must walk at all times, except as authorized by the Committee. Caddies are not permitted. Pull or push carts are permitted. Spectator carts are prohibited. Handicap carts will be available. Individuals must have documentation and be cleared by the JTNC staff. Visit the registration tent to be approved. For questions contact Kelly at kcimino@ncga.org.

Practice Round: Practice rounds are available before the tournament date. Players will pay the junior rate of \$10 per player. Parents or guardians wishing to play will pay the going adult rate available at the time of play. Cart fee is \$15 per player. Players must call the Windsor GC pro shop at (707) 838-7888 to arrange a time.

Food Service: Box lunches will be provided on Saturday prior to the shotgun start and a barbeque lunch will be provided on Sunday at the completion of the player's round.

<u>Withdrawals & No Shows</u>: Players who enter a JTNC event and wish to withdraw for any reason MUST notify the JTNC/NCGA staff at the Rules and Competitions department at (831) 625-4653. Failure to notify the JTNC/NCGA will result in a NO SHOW and the player will receive a one-year suspension from all JTNC events for the following calendar year following the infraction. A player who only contacts the course and NOT the JTNC/NCGA <u>will</u> incur the suspension.

Late Appearance: It is the responsibility of the players to be at their assigned tee at the time that the Committee orders play to begin. Order of play is not considered. The course will not page players to the tee.

Footwear: Non-metal spikes required. Shoes with traditionally designed spikes (regardless of composition, i.e., ceramic) or spikes, regardless of design, comprised either entirely or partially of metal (when such metal comes in contact with the surface of the putting green) are prohibited. Penalty for breach of this condition: Disqualification.

Dress Code:

Players and Spectators must be properly attired both on the golf course and on the premises of the club. Blue jeans, designer jeans, T-shirts and tank tops are prohibited. Golf shirts must be worn and shorts must be of appropriate length (no jean shorts). This dress code will be used at all JTNC competitions in conjunction with any additional dress code restrictions of the particular golf course involved. A violation of this dress code must be rectified without undue delay or the player will not be allowed to continue play. Spectators violating will be asked to change or leave the club.

Spectators: Spectators must wear proper attire while at the club. Please see the Dress Code policy above. Food service will be available at the restaurant.

The use of electronic devices should be limited to areas where their use will not distract players on the course. Spectators must maintain at least 25 yards from the players and avoid even the appearance of imparting advice or assisting the player in any way. A spectator may approach a player briefly to hand clothing, food or beverages to the player, but should not have prolonged conversations. Please walk ahead of the group you are following and stay in the rough or near the cart paths. Do not delay groups by walking slowly. Spectators must stay off the greens and out of the bunkers at all times. Spectators violating these policies may be asked to leave the course. Spectators are prohibited from using golf carts.

Ties: In the event of ties, there will be a play-off for first place. Ties for second and third will be decided using the USGA's method for matching cards. In a competition with a multiple tee start, the last nine holes will be holes 10-18.

Pro Shop & Range: The driving range will be available approximately 2 hours before the shotgun start. Players who have hit an excessive number of balls may be asked to step aside to allow others to warm up. The driving range will open at 7:00 on Sunday.

Tee Markers: The JTNC will not use Windsor's tee markers. Play will be from the tee markers with the JTNC logo. There will be three sets of tees, Blue (Boys Championship Flight), White (Girls Championship, Boys First Flights), and Red(Girls First Flight.

<u>Restrooms</u>: Located in Charlie's Restaurant near hole #10, and in the pro shop. Located between #4 green and #5 tee, #7 green and #8 tee, and #14 green and #15 tee.
