Notice to Competitors

The 2021 USGA Rules apply and are supplemented by the JTNC Hard Card and the following Local Rules. 2021 COVID Policies and Guidelines must followed and will be enforced.

Score Cards: The local rules on the Paso Robles scorecard/ yardage book are unofficial and have no status.

Tees: Play will be from where the tee markers are placed.

Boys Championship Flight: **Blue**; Boys First Flight & Girls Championship Flight: **White**; Girls First Flight: **Red**

Obstructions:

-Gravel cart paths are to be treated as an obstruction.

Powerlines: If a ball strikes the power lines on hole #7, the local rule requires that you cancel the stroke and replay the stroke without penalty (Local Rule E-11).

Maintenance Roads: Worn dirt areas, created by maintenance vehicles are an integral part of the course.

Out of Bounds: Defined by inside edges at ground level of white stakes or white lines, posts of perimeter fences and property lines. Public roads are out of bounds defined by the inside edge of the pavement. The driving range is out of bounds. **A ball that crosses a public road defined as out of bounds and comes to rest beyond that road is *out of bounds*, even though it may lie on another part of the course. (Local Rule A-3).**

Note: The clubhouse and blacktop parking lot are Out of Bounds

Protection of Young Trees: Protection of young trees is identified by stakes and/or cables. If such a tree interferes with a player's stance or the area of his intended swing, the ball **must** be lifted, without penalty, and dropped in accordance with the procedure prescribed in Rule 16.1f (No Play Zone in a Abnormal Ground Condition). If the ball lies in a penalty area and interference to the player's stance or area of intended swing exists from such a tree, the player must take relief either with penalty under Rule 17.1e or with free relief under Rule 17.1e(2).

Immovable Obstructions: French drains are considered an abnormal course condition. When adjacent to cart paths throughout the course are considered to be part of the cart path. A player is entitled to relief under the provisions of Rule 16.1 for both obstructions at the same time.

Pace of Play: The JTNC Pace of Play Policy is in effect; with maximum allowable times to complete each hole printed on individual score cards. **The Pace of Play is 4:48. 2:21 front/2:22 back with five-minute turn times.**

Final decisions on any disputed points will be made by the Tournament Rules Committee.

Restrooms: Located between holes 8 and 13.

Water: Ice chests with cold water will be located on holes 1 and 10.
