

JTNC Spring Series IV Paradise Valley Golf Course Saturday -Sunday, April 10-11, 2021

Notice to Players

(This information supplements the Championship Information and the 2019 JTNC Hard Card).

<u>Tees</u>: Boys Championship Flight – BLUE JTNC Tee Markers; Girls Championship and Boys First Flights – WHITE JTNC Tee Markers; Girls First Flight – RED JTNC Tee Markers

Protection of Young Trees: The young trees identified by stakes are no play zones:

- If a players ball lies anywhere on the course other than in a penalty area and it lies on or touches such a tree or such a tree interferes with the player's stance or area of intended swing, the player must take relief under Rule 16.1f.
- If the ball lies in a penalty area, and interference to the player's stance or area of intended swing exists from such a tree, the player must take relief either with penalty under Rule 17.1e or with free relief under Rules 17.1e(2). Mandatory Relief.

<u>Out of Bounds</u>: Defined by the nearest inside points, at ground level, of white stakes, driving range posts, and fence posts.

- In addition to the nearest inside points, at ground level, of white stakes, driving range posts, and fence posts, Out of Bounds is also defined by:
 - (i) The inside edge, at ground level, of continuous concrete strips when included or adjacent to property fences.
- ____A ball coming to rest on or beyond a public road is out of bounds, even if it comes to rest on another part of the course that is in bounds for other holes.

<u>Code of Conduct – Play of Hole #18</u>: During the play of Hole #18, a player must not deliberately hit the ball from the teeing area onto Hole #10. Penalty for Breach: **Disqualification**.

<u>Dropping Zones</u>: If a ball is in the penalty area in front of the green on Hole #3 and Hole #15, including when it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found came to rest in the penalty area, the player has these relief options, each for one penalty stroke:

- Take relief under Rule 17.1, or
- As an extra option, drop the original ball or another ball in the dropping zone, marked with white paint. The dropping zone is a relief area under Rule 14.3.

Penalty for Playing Ball from a Wrong Place in Breach of Local Rule: General Penalty Under Rule 14.7a.

Abnormal Course Conditions:

- The road between Hole #4 and Hole #5 is not a public road and does not define out of bounds. It is an immovable obstruction and relief may be taken in accordance with Rule 16.1.
- The oak trees and their wells on Hole #2 and Hole #14 are Ground Under Repair. Relief may be taken in accordance with Rule 16.1.

<u>Ground Under Repair</u>: Hole #17 all new sod areas on the fairway only, are deemed Ground under Repair and players may take relief. Other ground under repair will be as marked with white paint.

Please note: Not all of the new sod is painted white.

<u>Scoring Area:</u> The scoring area is the entry way/breezeway between the restaurant and golf shop. The score card is officially returned when it has been left with the Committee and the player has left this room.

<u>Deciding Tie(s):</u> In the event of a tie for first place, a hole-by-hole play-off will be conducted immediately following the conclusion of play for Championship flights only. Ties for 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} will be broken by matching score cards (Committee Procedures, Section 5A(6)).

Pace of Play:

Playing time today is 4 hours and 48 minutes. See separate notice regarding pace of play.
