



Restrooms: At 7th and 14th tees.
Check with Starter for the restroom code.

Spring Series IV
Rancho Murieta - North Course
April 24-25, 2021

The 2021 USGA Rules apply and are supplemented by the Hard Card, Pace of Play Policy, and the following Local Rules.

Score Card: The Rancho Murieta scorecard and yardage book have no status in the competition.

Tees: Junior Tour tee markers will be used. Play will be from where the JTNC tee markers are placed.

Blue: Boys Championship Flight. **White:** Boys First Flight & Girls Championship Flight. **Red:** Girls First Flight.

Protection of Young Trees: The young trees identified by stakes are no play zones. If a player's ball lies anywhere on the course other than in a penalty area and it lies on or touches such a tee or such a tree interferes with the player's stance or area or intended swing, the player must take relief under rule 16.1f. If the ball lies in a penalty area, and interference to the player's stance or area of intended swing exists from such a tree, the player must take relief either with penalty under Rule 17.1e or with free relief under Rule 17.1e(2).

Out of Bounds: Defined by white stakes/lines, boundary fence posts or white curb lines. To the right of #14 green North, left side of #3 North cart path and including the cart path curbs to the right of #18 North fairway and behind #18 North green.

Note: A ball that is on or crosses a public road defined as out of bounds is out of bounds even though it may lie on another part of the course. (Model Local Rule A-3) The road behind hole#2 green is a public road.

NO PLAY ZONES: The flower beds right #2 North green, left of cart path # 3 North green, left of #4 North green, or behind and to the right of #10 North green. Cabin on right side of fairway on #3 hole. Areas will be marked with white stakes with green tips and white paint lines. Free relief must be taken under Rule 16.1f. (Model Rule E-8) When a ball is in a No Play Zone in a Penalty area, the player must take relief under Rule 17.1d or 17.2

Please Note: White line areas of No Play Zones and the artificially surfaced road or path or other identified obstruction that tie into are treated as a single abnormal course condition when taking relief under Rule 16.1

Power Lines – If its known or virtually certain that a player's ball hit a power line (or tower or a wire or pole supporting a power line) during play of Hole 1 and Hole 3, the stroke does not count. The player must play a ball as nearly as possible at the spot from which the original ball was played in accordance with Model Local Rule E-11.

Maintenance Roads: Maintenance roads, gravel or dirt, are deemed to be integral parts of the course. Relief without penalty is NOT available.

Pace of Play: The JTNC Pace of Play Policy is in effect; with target times to complete each hole printed on individual score cards. The Pace of Play is 4 hours and 52 minutes, 2:26 front nine and 2:26 back nine.

Deciding Tie(s): In the event of a tie for first place, a hole-by-hole play-off will be conducted immediately following the conclusion of play for Championship flights only. Ties for 2nd and 3rd will be broken by matching score cards (Committee Procedures, Section 5A(6)).
