

JTNC Spring Series VI Corica Park Golf Course Saturday & Sunday, May 15th-16, 2021 Notice to Players

(This information supplements the Player Information and the 2021 NCGA Hard Card)

Tee Markers: Boys Championship - BLUE; Boys First & Girls Championship – WHITE JTNC Tee Markers; Girls First – RED JTNC Tee Markers

Pace of Play: Playing time today is 4 hours and 53 minutes. See separate notice regarding pace of play.

<u>Out of Bounds</u>: Defined by white stakes and the course side-edge of perimeter fence posts at ground level and paved perimeter roads and parking lots.

a. On Hole #5 the out of bounds area located around the back area of the putting green is defined by white stakes. But the actual out of bounds boundary around the back area of the putting green is the outside edge of the cart path curb. The cart path itself is an immovable obstruction.

<u>Penalty Areas</u>: Defined by Red and Yellow stakes/lines. To the left of #3, #4 and #6 green, behind #8 green and the left side of hole #13 and #14 the penalty area is defined by the outside edge of the cart path curb.

a. The red penalty area left of Hole #6 extends to infinity.

b. The red penalty area on the left side of Hole #16 extends to infinity.

Dropping Zone for Penalty Area during play of Hole #8: As an additional option for relief in accordance with Rule 17.1 under penalty of one stroke, when it is known or virtually certain that a ball is in the penalty area behind the putting green of Hole #8, the player may play from the drop zone provided.

Movable Obstructions: All blue stakes on the course are identifying sprinkler heads, drain covers, valve covers and other immovable obstructions. The blue stakes are movable obstructions and relief without penalty is available in accordance with Rule 15.2.

Ground Under Repair: GUR has been marked with white paint. If your ball is not found it must be known or virtually certain it has gone into the area of GUR. During the play of hole #6 t the left of the tee box the cut down trees and its debri are scheduled for removal and relief without penalty is available in accordance with Rule 16.1b.

Immovable Obstructions: Relief without penalty is available in accordance with Rule 16.1.

- a. The pump house and other outbuildings between Hole #1 and Hole #10 are immovable obstructions.
- b. All cart paths and maintenance paths are immovable obstructions.

Other Clarifications:

- a. **Preferred Lies in Bunker**: When a player's ball lies in a bunker, the player may take free relief once by <u>placing</u> the original ball or another ball in and playing it from this relief area:
 - <u>Reference Point</u>: Spot of the original ball
 - <u>Size of Relief Area Measured from Reference Point</u>: One club-length from the reference point, but with these limits:
 - Limits on Location of Relief Area:
 - o Must not be nearer the hole than the reference point, and
 - o Must be in the same bunker.

In proceeding under this Local Rule, the player must choose a spot to place the ball and use the procedures under Rule 14.2b(2) and Rule 14.2e.

<u>Touching of the flagstick is prohibited. The following Code of Conduct provision is in effect for this event:</u> The flagstick must not be removed or deliberately touched by hand during the round, including with a gloved hand or a towel wrapped around the flagstick. Any player who deliberately ignores this code of conduct policy will be considered guilty of Serious Misconduct (see Rule 1.2b), the penalty for which is disqualification.

Deciding Tie(s): In the event of a tie for first place, a hole-by-hole play-off will be conducted immediately following the conclusion of play for Championship flights only. Ties for 2nd and 3rd will be broken by matching score cards (Committee Procedures, Section 5A(6)).
