

## JTNC First Flight Tournament Coyote Creek Golf Course Sunday, June 27th, 2021

## **Notice to Players**

(This information supplements the Player Information and the 2021 NCGA Hard Card)

<u>Tee Markers</u>: Boys First — WHITE JTNC Tee Markers; Girls First — RED JTNC Tee Markers

Pace of Play: Playing time today is 4 hours and 53 minutes. See separate notice regarding pace of play.

<u>Out of Bounds</u> Defined by white stakes, white lines and the course side-edge of perimeter fence posts at ground level and paved perimeter roads and parking lots.

Please note: The inside edge of the cart path behind hole 9 and 18 defines out of bounds.

No Play Zones: No Play Zones are defined by Red or Yellow stakes with Green tops from which play is prohibited. Additionally,

- a. **Flower Beds**: Flower beds are no play zones that are to be treated as abnormal course conditions. Free relief must be taken from interference by the no play zone under Rule 16.1f.
- b. **Protection of Young Trees**: Staked trees and their wells are no play zones. If a player's ball lies anywhere on the course other than in a penalty area and it lies on or touches such a tree or such a tree interferes with the player's stance or area of intended swing, the player must take relief under Rule 16.1f. If the ball lies in a penalty area, and interference to the player's stance or area of intended swing exists from such a tree, the player must take relief either with penalty under Rule 17.1e or with free relief under Rule 17.1e(2).

<u>Integral Objects</u>: Worn areas created by maintenance vehicles and fire breaks throughout the course are Integral Objects. Relief without penalty is NOT available.

Immovable Obstructions Close to Putting Green: Relief from interference by an immovable obstruction may be taken under Rule 16.1. If an immovable obstruction is on the line of play, is within two club-lengths of the putting green and within two club-lengths of the ball, the player may take relief without penalty under Rule 16.1b, provided both the ball and the obstruction lie in a part of the general area cut to fairway height or less. See Model Local Rule F-5.

<u>Ground Under Repair:</u> GUR has been marked with white paint. If your ball is not found it must be known or virtually certain it has gone into the area of GUR. During the play of Hole 3, 14 and 15 the large piles of Mulch are scheduled for removal and relief without penalty is available in accordance with Rule 16.1b.

## **Other Clarifications**:

- a. **Preferred Lies in Bunker**: When a player's ball lies in a bunker, the player may take free relief once by <u>placing</u> the original ball or another ball in and playing it from this relief area:
  - Reference Point: Spot of the original ball
  - <u>Size of Relief Area Measured from Reference Point</u>: One club-length from the reference point, but with these limits:
  - Limits on Location of Relief Area:
    - o Must not be nearer the hole than the reference point, and
    - o Must be in the same bunker.

In proceeding under this Local Rule, the player must choose a spot to place the ball and use the procedures under Rule 14.2b(2) and Rule 14.2e.
